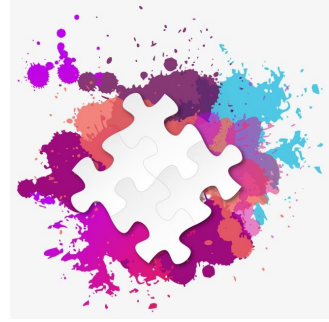

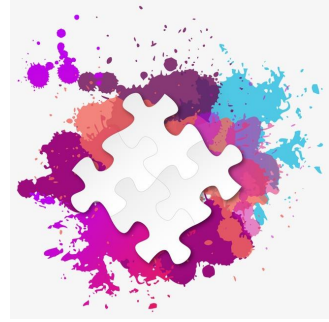

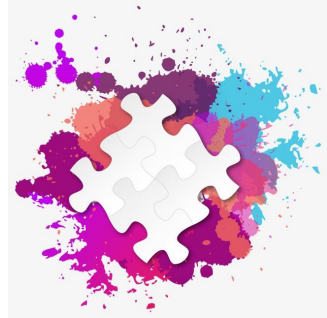

Note. The intention is for you to locate an existing chart for your organization. Most all organizations have them and Bon Secours has many for those of you who work within the system. It is very rare for an acute care facility not to have an organization chart. The creation of your own organization chart is only for those who are working in a location that does not have organization chart.


You will have to look around and do some digging to find the chart and the company's strategic plan. That is the point of the assignment - to explore parts of your organization that you have not in the past.

QM Fellowship Planning



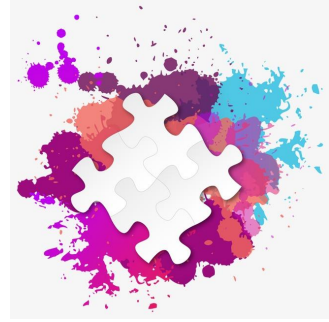
Steps:

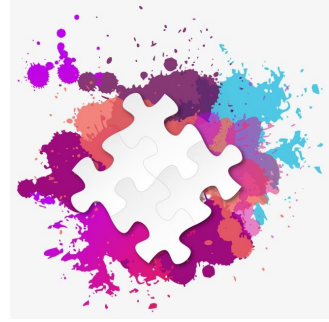

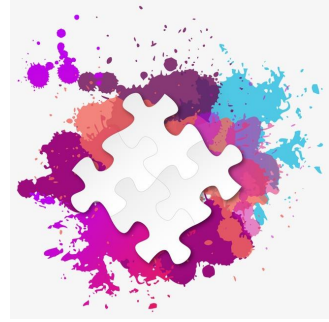


QM Fellowship Outcomes

Policy Recommendations



Recommendations Related to Student Needs:

- Review all policies to ensure online students are addressed
- Change the word “classroom” to “learning environment” in multiple policies
- Update the Students’ Rights and Responsibilities Policy to speak to environment and expectations of online learning
- Address online learner access of library services

Recommendations Related to Faculty Needs:

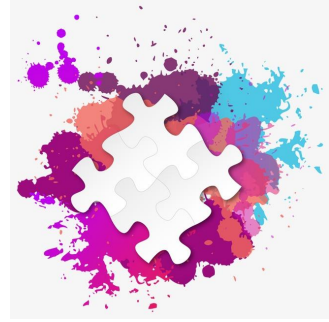
- Create policy on Intellectual Property

Recommendations Related to Online Student Orientation:

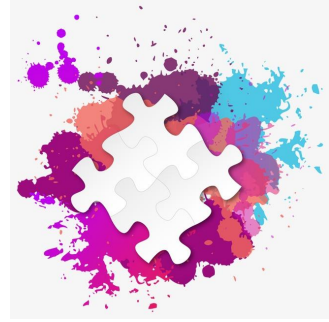
- Add academic reporting and privacy training

Student Services Recommendations



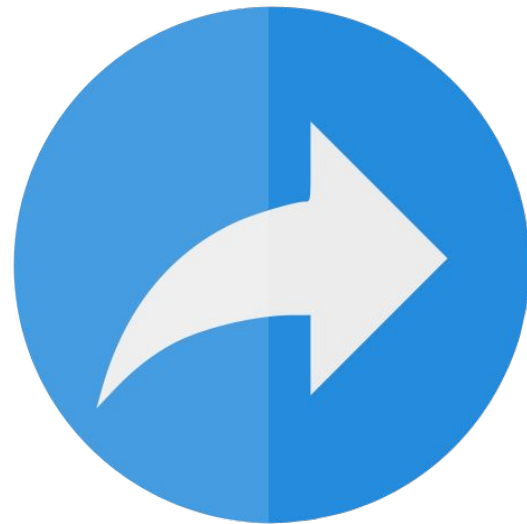
- Update student misconduct/behavior standards to reflect the online environment (Revisions are underway)
